**<u>SUBMISSION</u>**. A completed package shall include:

- Your typed essay
- A completed Contestant Information Form, (See Appendix A).
- If you are a high school senior, verification of enrollment
- High school graduating seniors, students currently enrolled (full-time/24 credit hours per year) in an accredited graduate, undergraduate college program, or trade school, and students enrolling in a (full-time/24 credit hours per year) program at an accredited college or trade school who have graduated from high school are eligible.

**ESSAY RULES.** Essays must be submitted as follows:

- Word count 500-1000. Word count cannot be less than or exceed the range.
- In the United States English language
- Typed:
  - Font Type: Times New Roman
  - Font size: 12 point
  - Double-spaced
- Hand written applications will be disqualified.
- Essays must include a title page with contestant's name separate from essay text.
- Do *NOT* include maps, drawings, pictures, or graphics.
- Plagiarism is NOT allowed.
- All sources must be properly cited on a separate page, per your grade level (i.e. *MLA*, *APA*).

JUDGING CRITERIA. Judges will rate the essays on the following:

1. Correct use of grammar, spelling, and punctuation	
2. Originality	
3. Overall Quality	
4. Critical Thinking
